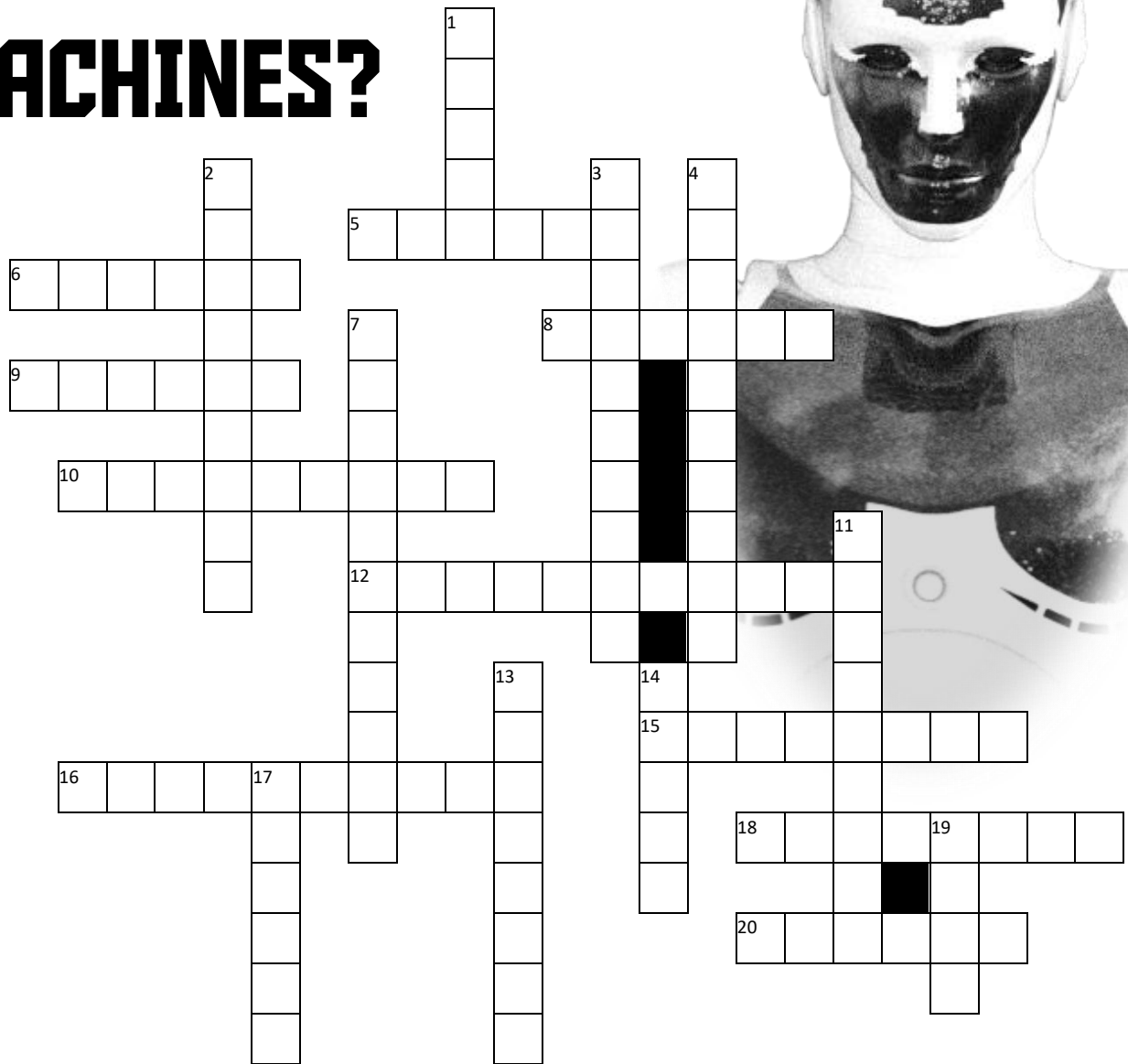


MEAN MACHINES?
